Bloomsbury--Cheap Lodging for Students--The International Students House, 229 Great Portland St., W<sub>1</sub>W 5PN (tel. 020/7631-8300; www.ish.org.uk), offers blandly furnished, institutional rooms for £33 (\$63) single, £25 to £27 (\$48-\$51) per person double, £20 (\$38) per person triple, and £18 (\$34) per person in a four-person mixed room. A £10 (\$19) key deposit is charged. Laundry facilities are available. Facilities include laundry machines, a bar, an Internet cafe, a fitness center, and sun beds. Reserve way in advance because these rooms go very quickly.



117/125 Cromwell Road, South Kensington. In a superb South Kensington location, just a short walk to Knightsbridge, comfort awaits in our tastefully appointed limited service hotel with full 4 star amenities. We have a restaurant and bar/tavern for your convenience. All rooms have full en-suite private bathroom, individually controlled air conditioning and heating, refrigerator, clock-radio, lap top sized safe, modem jack, trouser press, hair dryer, tea/coffee, satellite TV with remote (CNN,

CNBC, MTV, Euro sport, Sports Extra, Discovery, Cartoon Channel and Movies), and FREE CONTINENTAL BUFFET BREAKFAST. Two Double beds, KING size beds, singles, doubles and triples are all available. The David Lloyd's Health Club, which is the London Premier 6 story Health Club facility, is adjacent to the hotel and is available to hotel guests at a special reduced rate. Options range from a 1708 Chelsea town house to a terraced "Arts and Crafts" home built in 1914. A substantial breakfast is included in the price, and you share your digs with the hosts themselves, many of whom are artists, diplomats, business people, or, in some rare cases, lords of the realm who need extra money for living expenses. Prices begin at £100 (\$190) per night in a double or twin.
