VOLUNTEERING, CLASSIFICATION OF VOLUNTEERS

Volunteering is known as an altruistic activity, intended to promote good or improve human life. People also volunteer to develop their own skills, to meet friends, to make contacts for possible employment and to have fun. Volunteering is spending your time to something you believe free of pay. Volunteers earn respect and favors instead of money.

Volunteering takes many forms. Many volunteers are specifically trained in the areas they work in, such as medicine, education, or emergency rescue.

It is important to define the concept of volunteering on major sport events. In recent years, the role of volunteers and their contribution to sport and leisure received much attention.

Classification of volunteers

Different categories of volunteers will be involved in Universiade 2013. Each of categories demands specific requirements and strategies of recruitment, training and assignment. Volunteers are divided into 4 main categories:
